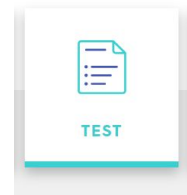
- ❑ **Step #1: Practice with the vocabulary set using the study feature, "Learn."** You must complete the prompts to the end of the activity to earn full credit. You should click "review" to review your progress at the end.



- ❑ **Step #2: Play one of the games. You may choose between Match or Gravity. You must complete the game to earn full credit. Gravity is complete at the end of level 3.**



- ❑ **Step #3: Take the test. When setting up the test, make sure you have included ALL WORDS in the set and ONLY check the box for MULTIPLE-CHOICE. Like the other features, you can redo the assignment until you improve. Take the multiple-choice test until you earn a 100%.**
